Every system is 100% custom — built for your RV and the exact appliances you want to run silently and reliably.

1. Solar Consult Call — Required First Step

Before we design or quote anything, we schedule a short consult call. Please have ready:

- **Make, model, and year** of your RV
- **List of appliances & devices** you want to power (air conditioner, microwave, residential fridge, lights, all outlets, TV, coffee maker, etc.)

This information lets us size the perfect system so you get full, reliable house power — not just a few extra outlets.

2. Full Electrical Integration — Real House Power

We integrate a high-quality inverter **directly into your RV's main electrical panel** so every outlet, AC, and appliance works exactly like shore power — but silent and off-grid.

- ✓ Every 120V outlet delivers full power
- ✓ Air conditioner, microwave, fridge & more run normally
- ✓ No generator noise or fumes

This is the key difference that makes our systems feel like a true upgrade, not an afterthought.

3. Payments & Securing Your Build Spot

We split every project into two clear payments:

Payment	When Due	What It Covers
Components	Up front	All solar panels, batteries, inverter, charge controller, wiring, etc. — brand new, top-tier brands only
Labor + Fab Items	At pickup	\$175/hour labor + any custom fabrication parts purchased during install (we make hardware store runs as needed)

Accepted payment methods: Credit/debit card, Zelle, ACH, or cash. **No personal checks** for labor unless funds have fully cleared in advance (usually 5+ business days).

We cannot reserve a spot in our install queue until the components are paid for. This keeps our schedule moving and fair for everyone.

4. Drop-Off, Build & Pickup

A few days before your RV is "on deck" (one position behind the current job), we'll text or call you to schedule drop-off.

We begin work **immediately** after you drop it off — we don't hold RVs for weeks or months like some dealerships. Most solar systems are completed efficiently once we start.

When labor is paid, you receive a full walkthrough and hands-on demo of your new system before you drive away.

- **All components:** Brand new, top-tier reputable brands only — never refurbished or carry-in parts
- **Parts warranty:** 1 year (in addition to manufacturer warranty)
- **Labor warranty:** 30 days
- **No carry-in parts:** We only install brand-new components we source — guarantees compatibility, warranty coverage, and reliability.
